

Timeline

Have your students build a timeline of their lives (or the life of a relative) using Post-it® Super Sticky Notes.

Supplies Needed:

Post-it® Super Sticky Notes & markers, pens or pencils



Start the lesson by explaining how timelines are a good way to visualize the major events in a given period of time, such as during a war or over the course of someone's life.

Model a timeline using each Post-it® Super Sticky notes to represent the stages of a child's life. Hand out a set of illustrated Post-it® Super Sticky Notes. Each should show an important milestone as well as the date of each event. Have your students place them on a whiteboard, wall or board in the correct chronological order.







Ask your students make a timeline of their own life. Each Post-it® Super Sticky Note will contain important dates, starting with their birth and working up to the present. Students have to record the most important things or events in their life.
